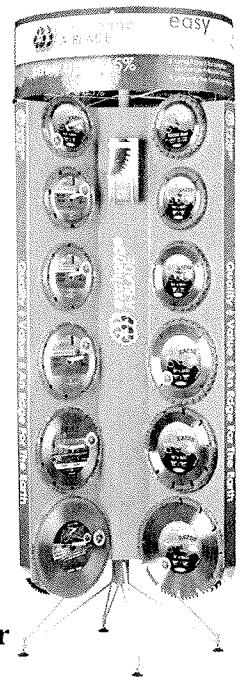

When the blade becomes worn, dull, or damaged; return the blade to us, trading it in for a new blade - paying the lower Exchange Price. The Exchange Price of the blade can save you up to 60% over the Original Purchase Price.

Be assured that quality has not been compromised with these remanufactured blades. Each blade undergoes a quality control process to ensure quality, performance, and longevity. All returned products are examined for damage, balance, and flatness. Those that pass inspection are sent through a cleaning and polishing process. Each cutting edge is then individually inspected. The worn or damaged blades that pass that inspection are ground to razor sharpness with diamond-grit machines. The blades are then inspected one more time, and packaged for sale. If at any time, the blades do not pass the test, they are taken out of the system and sent to a metal recycler.

You can find Exchange-A-Blade saw blades in our Detroit Lakes, Fergus Falls, and Moorhead stores.
